Moss phlox forming a huge carpet of blooms in Takinoue Park from mid-May to early June started from a single box of tiny moss phlox plants from a nursery that were planted there. These plants have grown year by year through the efforts of town's people, and are now covers an area of 100,000 square meters. It is the largest moss phlox community in Japan. Takinoue Town is covered by the vivid pink color and the sweet scent of the cute, tiny flowers.

In spring, the slopes of low hills in the park begin to turn light and dark pink with moss phlox. When they are in full bloom, broad slopes covering more than 100,000 square meters are covered with a beautiful velvet-like carnet of flowers.

## Koshimizu Wild Flower Park Spring Summer Autumn

It is a natural flower garden where approximately 70 species of flowers like *Ezosukashiyuri* (a variety of lilies) bloom all the way along an approximately 8 km long dune between the sea and the lake.

## Niji-no-Hiroba: Taiyo-no-Oka Engaru Park Engaru Town

It is one of the largest cosmos gardens in Japan that covers an area of 10 hectares with approximately 10 million cosmos plants. Moss phlox and tulips are in full bloom in spring, and cosmos and zinnia entertain in autumn.

## Wakka Wild Flower Park Kitami City

It is a seashore grassland that separates the sea of Okhotsk from Lake Saroma. The area is a mixture of forest, grassland, marsh and sand, and more than 300 kinds of flowers and plants can be found.
